What to bring to your appointment:

Unless you are helping someone else who needs an attorney, the only person who needs to come to the first visit is yourself. If you are helping someone else (such as your child or perhaps a dependent parent) then it is probably best for that person to attend the visit with you. Examples of helpful information to bring to the meeting include:

- Any letters, photographs, or other materials that can help explain the situation.
- Any legal documents you have about the situation, such as court orders, divorce decrees, and so on.
- Drivers licenses, insurance cards, passports and other documents that may relate to the situation.
- Names, addresses, and phone numbers of any people or companies who are involved.

Once we have reviewed the information you have, we may discuss other types of information that may be helpful to your situation.
